

**Articles of Incorporation**

**Northern New Mexicans Protecting Land, Water, and Rights, Inc.**

The undersigned, who are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the New Mexico Nonprofit Corporation Act, do hereby certify:

First: The name of the Corporation shall be Northern New Mexicans Protecting Land, Water, and Rights, Inc.

Second: The place in this state where the principal office of the Corporation is located in Santa Fe County, State of New Mexico, USA with the postal address of PO Box 37, Los Alamos, New Mexico 87544.

Third: Said Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, to help preserve land, water, and human and civil rights of community members. This Corporation of concerned citizens intends to lessen the stress of neighborhood tensions due to lack of information and fair representation. By providing a organization whose main goal is to unite and empower the community against prejudice and discrimination within community members, community deterioration can be stopped and repaired.


Fifth: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. The corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.



Sixth: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.


