

Meeting Minutes – NNMPLWR
Community Outreach Committee
June 30, 2014

Introductions made.

John Gutting offered a recap of the JMEC easement issues as well as upcoming JMEC events and meetings.

- Board of directors meet 4th Friday of each month
- Forensic audit being done on JMEC, inconsistencies found
- Gross conflicts of interest, not clear if criminal or not
- JMEC picnic coming up August 17
- Yearly general meeting in August (La Cueva)?
- District 6 members to visit other districts to reach out
- State requested delay of PRC meeting until end of July. Could be waiting for new commissioner to resolve this
- Breakdown of local/system costs in San I easements = 61% local 39% system, means that residents of El Rancho/San I take much larger chunk of rate hikes than in Ohkay Owinge rates
- Originally were to front-load 25 year lease rates into first 5 years, would result in 48% increase to electrical rates for residents, now will be spread over 22 years, renegotiation for next 25 years at that point
- No appraisal of land (Nambe did have land appraised at \$900/acre)
- San I lawyers demand \$100K from JMEC just to start negotiation while charging \$5K per day trespass.
- Jemez committee to form soon with George Gomez as chair

Paul White of United Communities of SF County presents county planning info and effect on Pojoaque Valley

- Overall, density of SF county zoning maps increase a lot
- Where will all the water come from
- Lots down to .3 acres
- Should be discussed by SF County Water Advisory committee

Then discussed community fundraiser/event on August 9th

- Co-chairs are Stella Shelburn and Sylvia Quintana
- Old high school gym can be used free of charge
- Must pay \$10/hr for security
- Committee to check on food/insurance/permits/music/donations for silent auction

Gail to open bank account and set up pay pal for payment of tickets and donations in general.

- Need to finalize IRS paperwork for non-profit status
