This is a request pursuant to the New Mexico Inspection of Public Records Act, NMSA 1978, §§ 14-2-1 et seq. (“IPRA”), on behalf of Northern New Mexicans Protecting Land, Water, and Rights.

According to State Statute, in order for an association to be granted state funds under the Acequia Community Ditch Fund (ACDF), an association is required to show proof that they represent the majority of the acequias in that district. In addition, it is the OSE that approves and validates that an association does in fact represent the majority of acequias in order to qualify for ACDF grant funds. Therefore, pursuant to IPRA, we request the documentation submitted to your office from Rio Pojoaque Acequia and Water Well Association that indicates the acequias within the Pojoaque Valley Irrigation District were in favor of this association representing them. Also, the list of acequias that were used to determine if a majority was met.

If you do not have these public record(s), please let me know. If this request needs to go to someone other than you, please forward to the appropriate records custodian or person.
